The **Federal Surplus Property Program** makes surplus property from federal agencies available to a variety of eligible participants, including cities, counties, state agencies, schools, museums, SBA 8(a) companies, fire departments, nonprofit organizations, and Service Educational Activities such as the Boys & Girls Scouts of America and American Red Cross.

The Program receives goods from all parts of the federal government, including all branches of the military, is funded entirely by handling fees that are paid by program participants for items they acquire, and saves Texas organizations millions of dollars each year.

The Program has a wide variety of property available including heavy equipment, office supplies, vehicles, tools, furniture and much more.

Feedback & Success Stories



The **Mid America Flight Museum** in Mt. Pleasant received this aircraft tractor (tug) in May 2015.



The **Brownsville Navigation District** received this 25' boat in June 2015 to use at the Port of Brownsville for port waterway and dock inspection, surveys and maintenance.



The **Texas Animal Health Commission** acquired this gooseneck trailer in May 2015. The original purchase price paid by the Federal Government

was \$43,200. TAHC paid TFC a service charge of only \$5,500, thereby saving this state agency over \$37,000!

The **City of West University Place** received this cargo truck in December 2015 to convert into a special response vehicle for their Fire Dept. The original purchase price paid by Federal Government for the truck was \$104,626. The service charge paid to TFC by the City was only \$7,500. The City's total investment in this vehicle to date is less than \$15,000. That's almost **\$90,000 in savings** compared to buying brand new!
