TFC Commissioners named Harvey Hilderbran as Executive Director of the agency in a meeting held Wednesday, January 21.

Hilderbran is a businessman and former lawmaker who served in the Texas House of Representatives for District 53 (Kerrville) from 1988 to January 2015. During his thirteen terms in office, he served as Chairman of the House Committee on Ways and Means; the House Committee on Culture, Recreation, and Tourism; and the House Committee on Human Services. Born in Uvalde in 1960, Hilderbran is a 1983 graduate of Texas Tech University. He replaces former TFC Executive Director Terry Keel who was recently appointed to a position with the Texas Department of Agriculture.

“Mr. Hilderbran’s business experience, combined with his extensive knowledge of state government, will be a tremendous asset in carrying out the duties of Executive Director of this agency. We are confident he will continue to strengthen delivery of the vital core services TFC provides to agencies of state government and, through them, to the people of Texas,” said Betty Reinbeck, Chairwoman of the seven-member Texas Facilities Commission.

TFC is responsible for providing a high quality work environment for state government that is functional, energy efficient, and cost effective. The statutory responsibilities of the agency include strategic planning for state facility needs; design, construction, maintenance, and operation of state-owned facilities; the planning and assignment of state-owned office space; providing office space for state agencies through leasing services; and various support services to state agencies, such as the reallocation and/or disposal of state surplus property, operation of the federal surplus property program, and coordination of recycling and waste management programs.
